Information Notice on the Processing of Personal Data (pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the European Regulation 2016/679/EU) (to be provided to those who complete Annex B of the Serena Saracino Study Award)

Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 2016/679 and in implementation of Legislative Decree 101 of 2018, the following information is provided in compliance with the principle of transparency, to ensure awareness of the characteristics and methods of data processing:

a) Data Controller and Contact Information

b) Data Protection Officer (DPO)

c) Purpose and Legal Basis of Processing

The processing of personal data required from the data subject is carried out for the performance of a task in the public interest or in connection with the exercise of official authority, **pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, letter (e) of EU Regulation 2016/679**, for the publication and reproduction of their images on any known or future technical and/or multimedia support, and for dissemination on any platform of the University, on its social media pages (Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, LinkedIn, Instagram, TikTok...), as well as to media and press outlets, for the videos submitted as part of the **SERENA SARACINO STUDY AWARD A.Y. 2023/2024**.

d) Types of Data Processed

- Personal data (name, surname);
- Residence address;
- Photographs, video recordings, and audio recordings in which identifiable individuals appear.

e) Mandatory Nature of Consent

Providing personal data is mandatory. Failure to provide such data will prevent the publication of the videos on the channels indicated in point c).

f) Processing Methods

The processing of personal data will be carried out using computer and telematic tools that are suitable for ensuring the security and confidentiality of the data itself.

For the achievement of the above-mentioned purposes, the data will be processed within the University of Turin by authorized individuals under the responsibility of the Data Controller, who have been adequately instructed and trained for this purpose.

g) External Data Processors

The data may also be communicated and processed externally by third-party providers of certain services necessary for the execution of the processing, who act on behalf of the Data Controller solely for the purposes of the requested service and who are duly appointed as "Data Processors" in accordance with Article 28 of EU Regulation 2016/679.

h) Categories of Data Recipients

Personal data will not be disclosed to third parties, except for the name and surname of the award winners, which may be published on institutional platforms and the University's social media channels, conferences and events, public seminars, flyers, books, brochures, magazines, and information and press channels.

i) Data Transfer to Third Countries

Personal data may be transferred to countries outside the European Union, as the Data Controller uses Google's services for the educational sector. Google utilizes IT infrastructures, equipment necessary for the interconnection of networks and users, and logging centers located in non-EU countries. Google has adhered to the Data Privacy Framework for the transfer of data between the EU and the USA, based on the adequacy decision adopted by the European Commission on July 10, 2023, under Article 45, paragraph 3 of the GDPR. Furthermore, within the contractual relationships with the University, Google complies with European regulations on data transfer as indicated in the Data Processing Amendment signed by the University, which contains the standard contractual clauses (see <https://cloud.google.com/terms/scs/eu-c2p>). With Implementing Decision (EU) 2021/914 of June 4, 2021, the European Commission issued the standard contractual clauses for the transfer of personal data to third countries in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

i) Data Retention Period

Personal data will be retained only for as long as necessary to fulfill the intended purposes.

l) Data Subject Rights
