### Admission procedure

Assessment of qualifications, research project and interview

### Qualifications to be uploaded in the on-line application

**Application form** (including abstract of thesis of Master Degree, publications lists, other qualifications, duly signed and with identification document/passport)

Candidates applying under condition: self-certification (using annex 5) with transcripts of records with marks, weighted average and credits relating to the Italian Laurea Magistrale. For international qualifications: submit on-line documentation as specified in art. 3 of this Call

**Research project** The RP shall be written in English by the candidate and it shall demonstrate the candidate ability and skills in pursuing independent research within the aims of the PhD program. We do not expect full paper nor 5 lines abstracts.

**Application fee: €50.00 for each application submitted** (1,50 Euro will be charged for each payment)

Candidates with international qualifications are exempted from paying the application fee.

**Application fee deadline: 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017 (mandatory deadline)**

<b>Publications</b>	Maximum score 10 points
<b>Other qualifications</b> Other degrees, specializations etc. with a special emphasis to those linked to the PhD aims	maximum score 10 points
<b>Research project</b> Written in English by the candidate along the lines of one of the topics indicated. It will be evaluated the scientific validity, the feasibility, the scientific potential.	Maximum score: 20 points
<i>Minimum threshold for admission to the interview</i>	30 points
<b>Interview</b>	<b>Maximum score: 40 points</b>
<i>Minimum threshold for passing the interview</i>	<i>20 points</i>
<b>Further information on examinations:</b> Courses are held in English. 1) Knowledge of English is mandatory 2) Candidates will be interviewed only in English. For candidates resident within 300 km from Turin, the interview will take place in Turin. For candidates resident over such a radius, at the discretion of the candidate, the interview may take place in Turin, or via ICT (eg Skype) on the same date as the Turin interviews. In this case, the applicant must provide the Skype address upon request. The Research Project (up to 2,000 words) must be drawn up by the candidate in English, choosing a title from the Ph.D. thesis.
