For applicants applying under condition, please also check Art. 5 of the Call • Research project, written in English by the candidate. It shall demonstrate the candidate ability and skills in pursuing independent research within the aims of the PhD program. We do not expect full paper nor 5 lines abstracts • Publications

Candidates will be assessed considering their <i>Curriculum studiorum and vitae</i> (as per information provided in the Application Form) and not exclusively according to the score of the Master's degree	Maximum score 20 points

Research project Written in English by the candidate along the lines of one of the topics indicated. It will be evaluated the scientific validity, the feasibility, the scientific potential.	Maximum score: 20 points

<p>Courses are held in English. Knowledge of English is mandatory. Candidates will be interviewed only in English. For candidates resident within 300 km from Turin, the interview will take place in Turin. For candidates resident over such a radius, at the discretion of the candidate, the interview may take place in Turin, or via ICT (eg Skype) on the same date as the Turin interviews. In this case, the applicant must provide the Skype address upon request.</p>	



The **Research Project** (up to 2,000 words) must be drawn up by the candidate in English, choosing a title from the Ph.D. thesis.
