Further information about the examination:

The **Writing Sample** must not exceed 10.000 ~~characters (spaces included)~~ words. The writing sample can be:

- an article which has already been published
- an article which has not yet been published
- a chapter of Master thesis written in English

The **Research Project** must not exceed the 14.000 characters (spaces included). The research project shall comply with the following structure:

- objectives;
- state of the art;
- methodology and work plan;
- bibliography.

Adequate knowledge of English at level B2 of the CEFR for Languages will be assessed.
