PRIVACY POLICY

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the European General Data Protection Regulation (UE/2016/679 Regulation, herein referred to as GDPR), the personal data provided shall be used by the University for **corporate teaching and research purposes, and for the purposes strictly related and instrumental to the activities set out in the release form above** (i.e. corporate communication). The personal data supplied, including personal portraits in pictures/videos, will be processed in accordance with the current legislation and non-disclosure obligations.

The data provided with this release form shall be processed with/without the use of electronic tools in compliance with the current legislation and the principles set out in art. 5 of the European Regulation (transparency, minimization, safety etc.).

We inform you that, to process the data, the consent of the interested party is not required. The legality of the processing is closely connected to the institutional purposes related to the activities for which the release is required. The provision of data is optional. In case of failure to provide personal data, it shall not be possible to use the pictures and / or the audio/video recordings of the relevant subject for the above mentioned purposes. Therefore, it shall not be possible to conclude the procedure, namely the event (e.g. seminar registration, interview). Personal data (such as pictures and audio/video recordings) may be used for communication, publication and / or dissemination in any form, within the limits concerning the stated processing purposes.

These data can be published on the University portal (www.unito.it), corporate sites of the University, thematic sites of the University, Unito media (corporate platform of multimedia content of the University - www.unito.it/media), UnitoNews (www.unitonews.it), 110 webradio (www.110.unito.it) and official pages of the University on [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#), [YouTube](#) and [Instagram](#). The data set out above could be extracted by common search engines in case of online searches made by third party subjects.

Data will be processed by authorized personnel (staff in charge of the platform technical support, researchers, etc.), and by authorized external collaborators, that have to comply with confidentiality and privacy. Data may also be entrusted to third-party companies operating in the ICT sector, appointed as external processors.

The University may hire, within their selection procedures, some external suppliers, and may use some Google services within the Educational field: suitable warranty measures have been taken (please read, for further details, the Google Privacy and Security section, quoted in the University website under [Privacy section](#)).

These services involve the transfer of personal data to an extra-European third country (these are the so called "in cloud" Google solutions). For the aforementioned data transfers, there is / does not exist a decision on the adequacy of the Commission or the reference to any suitable warranty, and the means to obtain a copy of such data or the place where they are available (in the case of transfers in Article 46 or 47, or in the second paragraph of Article 49 of the European Privacy Regulation).

At any time, it is possible to exercise the rights towards the data controller, as provided for in articles from 15 to 22, and as required by Articles 15-23 of EU Regulation 2016/679: right of access, update, cancellation, limitation to processing, right to object to processing

The interested party is informed that he/she has the right to complain to the authority, contacting the Personal data protection authority through the website: www.garanteprivacy.it

The audio/video recordings are assimilated to temporary processing activities finalized at the occasional publication of articles and respect the provisions contained in the:

- Code of Ethics related to the processing of personal data in exercising the journalistic activity set out in the Provision of the Personal data protection authority of 29th July 1998 attached to the "Code of Ethics" approved by the National Association of Journalists at the meeting of 27 January 2016 of which the provisions are an integral part.

- Provision on the matter of video surveillance of the Personal data protection authority – 8th April 2010 (which replaces that of 29 April 2004).

The data shall neither be processed for commercial or marketing purposes nor transferred to third parties, and shall be stored for the time necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected, in compliance with the principles set out in Art. 5 of GDPR. The data provided, made anonymous, can also be used for statistical surveys. No profiling shall be undertaken on the basis of personal data provided.
