

Residence permit





- Only for NON-EU students, owning a Study visa type D
- To be requested within 8 working days after the arrival in Italy. Due to COVID-19 emergency the 8 days should be counted starting from the end of the possible quarantine. For detailed information on quarantine disposals please, check the <u>Italian Ministry of Health website</u>.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Passport + 2 Copies of personal data and Visa
- 1 duty stamp (16 euro value) purchasable in a tobacco store
- Codice fiscale (>> Agenzia delle Entrate)
- Letter of acceptance
- Health Insurance
- Documentation proving financial resources availability

EU citizens:

Guests coming from EU countries can access to health care supplied by "SSN- Servizio Sanitario Nazionale" (National Health Service). They can benefit from:

- Family doctor and hospital services
 - ASL located nearby the residential area

Extra-EU citizens:

You can choose between **two kind of health care coverage**:

- Italian National Health Service ("Servizio
 Sanitario Nazionale, SSN"): it offers full coverage
 including the possibility to choose a family
 doctor- upon the payment of a €149,77 calendar
 year fee (that is January 1st to December 31st).
 You may contact the local National Health Service
 Unit (ASL) for information.
- Private insurance: upon your arrival in Italy, you can purchase one. If you need suggestions, you can ask to the Residence permit office of the University of Turin, because a health care insurance is required to apply for a residence permit.
