A Proof of Concept (PoC) is a demonstration or a prototype of a concept, idea or technology that is used to validate the feasibility and potential success of a project. It is typically based on a small-scale project that aims to prove the viability of an idea or technology, and to gather feedback from stakeholders.

In this context, Re-UNITA's Seeding Proof of Concept program will provide seeding funding for a small proof of concept project among those presented by teams comprised of at least two Re-UNITA partners. The objective of this call is to empower R&I based entrepreneurship in the UNITA community and to contribute to the cooperation between members of the different Universities of Re-UNITA project.
