Research areas:

Comparative law, legal theory, legal history, legal anthropology, law and translation studies

Research interests:

All research fields involving the theoretical and methodological problems arising from the study of law in comparative and historical perspective. I take a special interest in legal anthropology, the cognitive approach to the study of legal cultures and the study of individual agency in the law, as well as in the empirical study of legal cultures and justice systems. This includes the relationship between formal and informal rules, and the way in which language, power and the law are interrelated (both within and across national boundaries, as well as in multilanguage environments, such as the European Union). In the field of private law, I have carried out comparative research on a wide number of subjects ranging from rights, trust and property law, contracts and torts.
