In order to achieve this goal, UNITA has designed new forms of mobility:

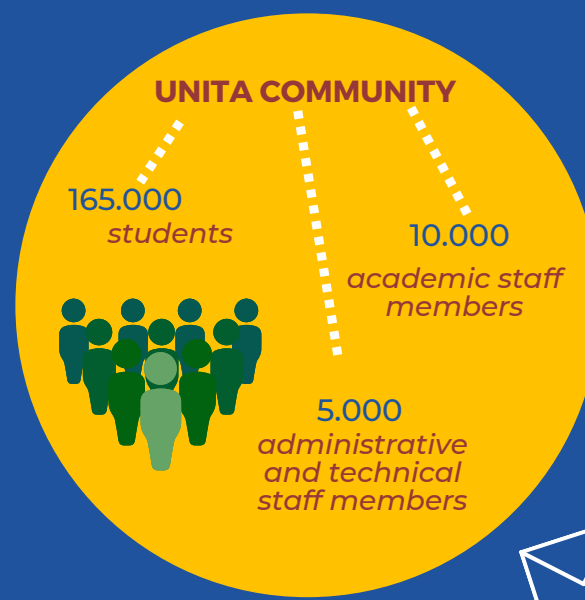
- **UNITA Rural Mobility**

This innovative approach allows anyone to communicate in her or his own language and to be understood by others. It is a great tool to facilitate communication and exchanges between the partners of the alliance.



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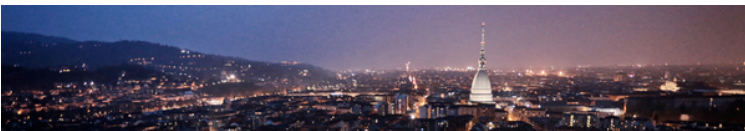

UNITA aims at enabling all learners to **acquire international and intercultural competences** through internationalisation of the curricula or participation in innovative international environments in their home institutions, and to **experience some form of mobility**, whether in physical, digitally enhanced (virtual) or blended formats.

In November 2020, the Alliance **UNITA - Universitas Montium** officially started, grouping **six universities** across Europe.
